Guidance for speakers and participants

In-person events and meetings

The Official Spanish Chamber of Commerce in Belgium and Luxembourg is delighted to welcome you back to in-person events and meetings. To keep everyone safe, we would like to inform you of our hygiene and protection measures which we kindly ask you to follow.

- Only speakers and participants who are [“covid-safe”](#) are permitted to attend in-person meetings. You should be prepared to provide proof if requested.
- We ask you to stay at home if you are ill with any symptoms of a cold (especially fever, cough and/or shortness of breath). Further to this, you should not attend if you are subject to any quarantine or isolation requirements e.g. when returning from a “high-risk” country.
- Wear a mask whilst not seated.
- Respect a social distance of 1.5m while seated by following the guidance provided.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in the meeting or event room.
- If you fall ill during an event or meeting, we ask you to leave the building and seek medical attention. If you do have a subsequent positive covid test, we ask you to inform us as soon as possible so we can contact the other participants.

New and amended measures may come into place from the Belgian authorities, please keep up to date on the latest developments.
