About the committees of the Chamber

Context



According to Article 34 of the Statutes of the Chamber *“in order to defend the interests of its members and to support, with the best guarantees in terms of efficiency, the activities of the Chamber, **Committees** may be organized, which shall be of a consultative nature (...) All members can ask the Secretary General to create a new group (...)”*



At the beginning of the year 2019, several members in Luxembourg proposed the creation of a Committee focused on the financial sector, which would bring together companies whose activity is associated with this sector and maintain a link with Spain



The general objectives, the information about the conditions of participation as well as the internal functioning of the **Spanish Financial Forum in Luxembourg** (name adopted for this Committee) are established below



The aim of this Committee is to create in Luxembourg a space for opinion and debate on economic and financial issues where professionals working in companies related to the provision of financial services who are members of the Chamber can share experiences, establish collaborations, exchange information on sector trends and generate business opportunities. It also aims to position itself as the main "hispanic" interlocutor with the Luxembourg institutions in the financial sector



General Objectives



To improve the **image and perception that Luxembourg projects** in Spain, mainly in professional environments.



To act as the **main “hispanic” interlocutor** and lobby to the Luxembourg financial sector authorities



To facilitate **networking** among the members of the *Spanish Financial Forum in Luxembourg* (SFF), so that they can share experiences, establish partnerships, exchange information on industry trends and debate about legal, fiscal and regulatory issues



To act as a link to **Latin American markets**




To encourage the **attraction and retention of Spanish talent** to Luxembourg



Contribute to strengthening Luxembourg's leadership as a **financial center in Europe**

Proposed Actions 2020-2021

Examples



Preparation of ***position papers*** in those areas considered strategic, which serve to convey the conclusions drawn from the meetings and activities of the SFF to the Luxembourg authorities and European institutions

Organisation of activities aimed at improving the social integration and professional development of young Spanish talent living in Luxembourg. Creation of the **“Spanish Young Talent Network”**


Organisation of breakfast discussions with representatives of bodies such as the CSSF, Luxembourg for Finance, ALFI, LPEA, etc. as well as European institutions on topics considered to be of interest to the members of the Commission, enabling the SFF to be presented 'formally' before relevant bodies

Prepare a **publication in Spanish** that includes information on Luxembourg as a "hub" of international finance and clearly presents the **myths and realities of the Grand Duchy** in this sector.

Organisation of **seminars in Spain** to promote the competitive advantages offered by Luxembourg as a financial centre.

Internal Functioning Structure

Each sub-sector will be led by a member company



All **members of the Chamber** whose activity falls within the framework of the Committee may submit a request to participate



Each member company can appoint a **maximum of three representatives**. Preferably, the different representatives of the same company should be specialized in different working areas, always within the financial sector



Activities under the SFF will be mainly funded from income from membership fees and sponsorships



The decisions of the SFF cannot, under any circumstances, engage the responsibility of the Chamber, or replace the Board of Directors in any act of an official nature
